

BOYS LACROSSE TOURNAMENT COVID-19 MEASURES

- Participants (players and coaches) are strongly encouraged to be accompanied to the tournament by at most one family member.
- All attendees are to perform a self-evaluation prior to entering the Warhill Sports Complex. Any individual who has a fever or symptoms of COVID-19, or known exposure to a COVID-19 case in the prior 14 days is not permitted to enter the facility.
- Shade tents are permitted but all attendees must adhere to Virginia guidelines regarding COVID-19. This includes non-family members maintaining six feet of social distancing when not engaged in competition. It also includes the wearing of face masks/covers.
- Attendees are asked to bring their own hand sanitizer and/or disinfectant wipes. Hand sanitizer will be available at the Tournament Desk and on every playing field.
- The concessions booth will not be in operation but a food truck will be on-site, offering a variety of food and beverages for purchase.
- Water will not be provided at the fields. All participants must bring their own water and/or sports drink. Shared team water coolers and/or drink stations are prohibited.
- Spectators must observe games from outside the playing area. Only players, coaches, officials and Colonial Challenge staff will be permitted within the fenced athletic areas.
- Participants are prohibited from sharing equipment and/or personal items unless properly sanitized between use.
- A "no touch" rule will be enforced during competition. Participants are expected to refrain from high fives, handshake lines, and other physical contact with teammates, opposing players, coaches, officials, and fans.
