## 07 | Tournament Policies

This section is meant to outline Y'all's facility and tournament policies, not tournament rules. Tournament rules will be made available to coaches for review at the time of schedule release.

**The following items are prohibited within Y'all's Ballpark:**

**Metal Spikes** - these void the warranty of our turf playing surface. Any player found to be wearing them will be immediately ejected from the current game, as will their coach. Repeat offenses will result in suspension for the remainder of the tournament for both the player and coach, or forfeiture of the team from the remainder of the tournament.

**Chewing Gum** - chewing gum voids the warranty of our turf playing surface.

**Outside Food and/or Beverage** - concessions will be available for purchase at Y'all's Ballpark. We do not mind if you eat elsewhere, but you cannot bring it in here.

**Sunflower Seeds** - these are difficult to clean and clog dugout drains. The field and dugouts will be inspected for use of seeds. Any team found to have seeds will be fined \$100 per occurrence.

**Tobacco and/or Vaping Products** - Smoking is prohibited within stadium grounds.

**Pets** - service animals are welcome.

**Player Safety and Supervision:**

Teams are forbidden from taking the field until their liability waivers have been submitted.

Horseplay and roughhousing are prohibited.

No sitting or standing on the dugouts or stadium walls.

Activities that create excessive noise and/or distract from gameplay are prohibited.

**Parents, family guests and spectators** of Florence Y'all's tournaments assume all risk and danger of personal injury, losses, damages to person and property and all hazards arising from or related in any way to the events at Y'all's Ballpark that they are attending, including COVID-19. The Florence Y'all's reserve the right to refuse admission to, or eject any person whose conduct is deemed by management to be disorderly or who fails to comply with rules and regulations set forth by Y'all's personnel.





## 08 | COVID-19 Safety Protocols

**The ongoing Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic is of concern to all of us. Our lives has been disrupted in ways previously unimaginable thanks to it. Our organization has been fortunate to reopen and welcome fans through our gates for amateur events as well as Y'all's games. We are proud that in more than 50 unique events in which fans were in attendance, we experienced NO cases of COVID-19 among our players, staff, and fans.**

**We ask that you please follow the regulations that we have put into place for your safety and the safety of those around you. We enjoy welcoming you to our tournaments, and we would like for that to continue.**

If you have felt sick or shown symptoms of illness in the last 24 hours, we ask that you stay home and follow your tournament on Y'all's social media and Tourney Machine.

Temperatures of all guests will be taken upon entry into Y'all's Ballpark using a forehead scan thermometer. Any guest with a temperature 100.4 or above will not be granted entry.

All players, coaches and spectators will be required to wear a facemask while at Y'all's ballpark. Masks must be worn:

- Upon entry to Y'all's Ballpark
- When in the company of others outside of your family or household
- While walking on the concourse, waiting in line at the concession stand, browsing the team shop, or using the restroom
- All coaches and players are required to wear masks unless they are on the playing field

If you are seated with your families and properly social-distanced, you are welcome to remove your masks. Guests are asked to maintain proper social distancing protocols.

We are currently not permitted to provide water coolers for teams inside dugouts. Players are permitted to bring their own water. Players are REQUIRED to provide their own.

**We thank you for your cooperation as we continue to do what we can to ensure the safety of our guests, and so that we continue hosting events here at Y'all's Ballpark.**
