

4th Annual Next Level Fall Classic Rules

1. TEAMS SHOULD ARRIVE 20 MINUTES BEFORE SCHEDULED GAME TIME – **You will not be allowed into facility until your court is open and has been cleaned and cleared out. Site directors will bring in teams by court when available.**
2. Each game will consist of two (2) fourteen-minute stop time halves. It will be running time for final 2 minutes of 2nd half if a lead is 20pts or more. It will stop again if lead goes under 20.
3. There will be a Two-minute intermission between halves.
4. There will be two (2) 30 sec time outs per half. No carryover into the second half.
5. An overtime period will be 2 minutes. Teams will only have 1 timeout in OT. No carryover.
6. Double Overtime will be Sudden Death, 1st Point wins.
7. The 7th team foul of each half will result in one and one situation. The 10th Team foul will result in double bonus.
8. A player is disqualified on his/her 6th foul
9. Substitutes must report to the scorer's table and be ready to enter the game when called by referees.
10. No full court press with a 15 or more point lead. Please use best judgment – sportsmanship is key
11. 4th Grade Divisions will only play Man to Man Defense, help and recover.
12. 4th grade special full courtman rules: a. Player cannot defense the transition until the ball crosses half-court. b. Full court man is only allowed in last 2 minutes of game and if up by less than 10 pts. c. Full court man is allowed in entire overtime period(s).
13. Official Scoring: Tournament will provide the score keeper. 1 parent/coach from either team will be asked to do official scorebook at table.
14. All players, coaches, officials and spectators are required to wear masks upon entering the building. Only players will be allowed to remove mask when entering the game. Masks must stay on while on bench.
15. Coaches will need to wear masks appropriately and covering nose and mouth. Officials can issue a warning followed by a technical for not following rules.
16. At the conclusion of game play, there will not be handshakes. Teams must pack up and exit the gym unless scheduled for a back to back game. Any team huddles will need to take place outside of the building.

Most importantly, COACHES, PLAYERS, and SPECTATORS are expected to show GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP. There will be zero tolerance for poor sportsmanship. Tournaments officials reserve the right to ask anyone to leave the gym.
