## GENERAL INFORMATION:

- Pool Play on Friday \& Saturday- Single Elimination Tourney Sunday. 4 Game Guarantee in divisions with 6 or more teams
- Coaches need to report scores at the tournament headquarters
- Tournament Brackets and scores will be posted on Tourney Machine and also tournament Facebook page (Black Hills Memorial Softball Tournament)
- Game Balls will be provided
- Each team is responsible for cleaning up the dugout area after each game
- Championship Plaque and Medals for $1^{\text {st }}$ and $2^{\text {nd }}$ place Teams


## ROSTER:

- Prior to first game, the team manager/coach must provide a team roster at check in and provide proof of USA sanction.
- 3 USA sanctioned pick up players are allowed-names and numbers must be on the roster
- Birth certificates must be available upon request


## GAME SPECIFICS:

- 7 innings or 75 minutes in U12, U14, U16, U18 divisions (whichever comes first) for pool play and bracket play
- 7 innings or 70 minutes for U10 division (whichever comes first) for pool play. 7 innings or 75 minutes for bracket play.
- Umpires decisions are final- No Protests. Coach are responsible for conduct/sportsmanship of players and fans. We appreciate and will stand behind our umpires.
- Home plate umpire is the official clock.
- Home team determined by coin flip and is official book.
- Please be prepared to start at least 30 minutes before scheduled game time.
- Due to inclement weather, or other act of God, a completed game will be: 4 innings (or $31 / 2$ if the home team is ahead)
- Tiebreaker System: Pool Games MAY End in a Tie. Bracket Games are decided by the USA Rules.
- A tie in pool play will count as neither a win or a loss for both teams-it is simply a tie


## RUN RULES

- 12 Runs after 3 innings of play
- 10 Runs after 4 innings of play
- 8 Runs after 5 innings of play


## U10 GAME SPECIFICS

- U10 can steal home
- U10 may advance on a $3^{\text {rd }}$ drop Strike
- U10 will play 5 runs per inning or 3 outs


## GAME SCORES

- A coach from each team needs to report game scores to tournament headquarters or text Tournament Directors Final score
- Scores and updates will be posted on Tourney Machine and FaceBook Page


## APPEALS

- NO PROTEST TOURNAMENT


## WARM-UPS

- Please conduct warm-ups prior to game time and please be prepared to start at least 30 minutes before scheduled game time.
- Please be respectful if the fields are chalked and do your best to take warm ups between the chalk lines.


## USA REGISTRATION AND INSURANCE

- This is a USA softball sanctioned tournament. Teams must supply proof of insurance upon request- Rapid City League Teams you are covered.


## TOURNAMENT PLAY

- The Tournament Director (s) reserve the right to change the format of the tournament if it deems necessary


## SEEDING PROCEDURE

Pool play results will determine seeding into Sunday's single elimination tournament. In the event of a tie in pool play, seeding will be based on the following:

1. Win/Loss Record
2. Head to Head
3. Runs Allowed
4. Run Differential
5. Runs Scored
6. Coin Flip
7. A forfeited pool play game will be 7 run allowed for every game that is a forfeited.

Ties Are Allowed in Pool Play: Ties will be counted as neither a win or loss for both teams. It is simply a tie.

## 4 GAME GUARANTEE

Teams will be scheduled for 3 pool play games. If your opponent forfeits that is a game that will be scored and recorded accordingly. Tournament directors will not find or provide another team for you to play due to a forfeit. Tournament directors have no control over a forfeited game.

## WEATHER/DELAY/CANCELLATION

If at least 2 official games by rule are played or are available to play, no re-imbursement will be offered or given.

## ZOOM COACHES MEETING

We will have a coaches meeting via zoom the night before we draw for brackets (Thursday May $\left.13^{\text {th }}\right)$. We will discuss all rules. No rule will be negotiable to change after we draw the brackets.
