## Rock the Cages Game Play

- 1. Games are 25 minutes with a running clock. Games start when both teams are ready for play. Time will be kept on a central clock. A 1 minute warning will be given. A 10 second countdown followed by a horn to end the game.
- 2. There are no called time outs. The play will stop for an injured player but the clock will continue to run.
- 3. A draw is performed after every goal. Free positions are not awarded regardless of score.
- 4. Ties are permitted in pool play. In playoff games a braveheart with 2 field players and a goalie from each team will be performed immediately.
- 5. Games are over when the horn sounds regardless of the on-field situation with the exception of an 8m free position. All 8m free positions must be played out even if time has expired after the foul. Referee decisions are final.
- 6. Scorers will track time on yellow cards. Time starts once play restarts. 2 minutes of running time.
- 7. Checking is determined by the division. Scorers will have the level at the table.
- 8. Coaches must sign the scorecard after the game. Any disputes of the score must be made before signing.
