

### **Rock the Cages Information**

1. Check-In - A representative from each team must check-in at the main HQ tent prior to your first game. This is located at the concession stand. Please bring a copy of your roster with name, jersey number and US lacrosse number. Include the head coach's name and cell number with the roster. If your club does not require being a US Lacrosse member, please bring a copy of your club's insurance certificate to hand in.
2. Schedule - Double check the schedule. We all want a smooth day and understanding the schedule is key. Some of you may be very familiar with tourney machine site and app and some may be seeing it for the first time. You will have pool games and then based upon the results you may advance to bracket play. DO NOT LEAVE for the day without having someone check out at HQ. This has happened each year and it is no fun for the team who stays and does not have an opponent.
3. Awards – We will present awards to the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place team in each division. Our plan is to award the medals to the champions at the concession stand/ HQ.
4. Facility – We have a great facility and we would like to continue to receive access to it each year. Please keep the area clean, do not park on the grass and respect the community in and around the fields. Vehicles are not permitted on the paved walking paths or parked on the grass. Portable bathrooms will be available at the sides of the fields and at the concession stand. Coaches and players are the only ones permitted on the playing surfaces.
5. Vendors – We will have the vendor village near the concession stand. Food and drinks will be available throughout the day along with several clothing vendors.
6. Game Play – Please remember to honor the game. Treat officials and the other teams with respect. This is a competitive format, but the focus should still be on the players and letting them enjoy the day. Keep in mind their ages. There will be no scholarships handed out on Saturday or Sunday. The division and tie breaker rules are found in the documents section of the site.
7. Parking – Please park in marked spot and not in the grass.
8. Team Tents – There is plenty of room for team tents along the walking path surrounding fields 1 and 2. Please do not place a tent inside any of the fenced areas on the turf or directly next to a grass field.
