## TOURNAMENT RULES: BOYS

## GENERAL

## NO TAKE-OUT CHECKS BY ANY PLAYER AT ANY LEVEL

Excessive physical play, fighting, foul language, excessive "trash talk," and disrespect toward players, officials, coaches, or parents by any players, coaches, or spectator will not be tolerated. Tournament directors will handle situations on a case by case basis in consultation with officials and reserve the right to remove those culpable.

Games and penalties are running time; 22 minutes during pool play and playoffs. 222 minute halves for Championship games. (in the event of a prolonged injury stoppage, officials may stop time)

All teams with a lead must keep the ball in the box for the last two minutes of the game. Referee has sole discretion to award ball to opposing team if they interpret the current team with ball is stalling outside of the $\mathbf{2}$ minute period. We want lacrosse played for $\mathbf{2 2}$ minutes in all pool play.

No overtime during pool play; playoff rounds will go to continuous sudden victory overtime period if tied

Standing: win $=3$ pts, tie $=1 \mathrm{pts}$, loss $=0$ pts
Seeding: record, head-to-head, goals against, goal differential (7 goals max per game), win/loss versus common highest ranked opponent, coin toss

A forfeit will be posted as a 1-0 victory for the non-forfeiting team

Field marshals will keep score and check with referee on any discrepancy;
Teams with illegal players (by age or by incorrect rosters) will forfeit games $\&$ will be disqualified.
In the event of a goalie penalty where a team does not have a back-up goalie ready to play, an on-field attackmen will be selected by the officials to serve the penalty unless they determine the goalie's actions unsportsmanlike.

Program team directors or head coaches may report disputes to the Event Directors. All disputes will be settled by the Event Director(s) or his/her designee. Judgment calls, including goal timing, is not a misapplication of the rules and therefore may not be challenged.
