TOURNAMENT RULES

*Based on MIAA HS Rules

- 1. Bat Regulations
 - a. 13U: USA Stamped Bat or BBCOR (-3)
 - b. 14U: BBCOR (-3)c. 15U-18U: Wood
- 2. 2 Hour Time Limit No new full inning may start after the 2:00 mark.
- 3. Teams may hit as many players in their lineup as they desire.
 - a. If a player is injured/ejected/removed from game and there is no legal player to replace them, an out will be recorded when their spot in the lineup comes up.
- 4. Re-entry rule. A player can only re-enter in the same spot ONCE and then that player he goes back in for is done for that game. You cannot re-enter for a different player. You can never hit in 2 different spots in the line-up during a game.
 - Re-entry for a pitcher: In the event a pitcher is substituted with a pinch-runner or hitter, the pitcher may re-enter the game immediately as long as another pitcher does not throw a pitch. If he re-enters after someone else throws a pitch, he will not be allowed to pitch in that game.
- 5. Rune Rule: 15 after 3, 10 after 4.
- 6. Coin Flip for Home/Away at Ground rules before each game between umpires and each team's Head Coach or Team Representative.
- 7. No Courtesy Runners
- 8. No Extra Innings even if under the time limit. Game will end in a tie after 7 complete innings.

PLAYOFFS

- 1. Top 2 teams in each pool will qualify for playoffs.
 - a. Higher seed is automatically the home team (unless team chooses away).
 - b. Semifinals = Pool A #1 vs Pool A #2 & Pool B #1 vs Pool B #2
 - c. Championship = Winner of Semifinals
- 2. Seedings are determined by:
 - a. #1 Overall Record
 - b. #2 Head-to-Head
 - c. #3 Runs Allowed
 - d. #4 Run Differential
 - e. #5 Coin Flip
- 3. Playoff games do not have time limits.
- 4. Extra Innings Rules
 - a. Each inning will start with bases loaded, 1 out.
