- 16 Team Single Elimination for the Championship. (15 Pool winners, 2nd place team in Pool 12) **teams losing first bracket game, will play 1 consolation game
- ***Pool 12 if there is a 3 way tie, the top team will be determined by tie breakers, once that team is pulled out, the tiebreakers will start over from the top to determine the next place team.
- *** 40 teams will be placed in ten 4 team consolation pods where the winners and losers play.
- *** The final 6 teams will play 2 consolation games each.
