

Chad Wolff Classic Rules

Pool play games are played on Thursday and Friday

Bracket games are played on Saturday and Sunday

Home Team determined by coin toss in pool play (Thurs. & Fri.). Higher seed is home team in bracket play (Sat. & Sun.)

NFHS (High School) Rules with the following exceptions...

7 Inning (or time limit) games

Time Limit

- All games will have a 2-hour time limit
- Finish the inning that has started
- Time starts on 1st warmup pitch

Extra Innings

- Pool play games can end in a tie (Thurs. & Fri.) at the end of time limit.
- If time is left on the clock and game is tied, continue playing until someone wins or 2-hour time limit. *Example: teams have played 1:40 and game is tied at 2-2. Keep playing until someone wins or time expires.*
- Bracket play games must have a winner.
- All extra innings will be played using International Tie Breaker (last batter from previous inning placed on 2nd base to start the next inning).

Run Rules

- 10 after 4
- 8 after 5

Pitcher faking a throw to 3rd is a balk (no 3rd to 1st moves).

Balks are not dead immediately (play it out).

Mound visits: 1 per pitcher, per inning, before he has to be pulled.

Any player can run for the pitcher or catcher.

Open substitution as long as a player returning to the game stays in his original spot in the order.
