

2021 Legacy Lacrosse Fall Classic Tournament Guidelines

Teams Will Play 2- 20 minute halves 2 minute halftime 3 minutes in between games Championship will be one 20 minute half

High School, Middle School, Youth (2028, 2029) DIVISIONS (12v12)

*All US Lacrosse Rules apply at this event

- Teams must be ready to take the field at the conclusion of the previous game. Please be ready to play as you enter the field.
- Time outs: There are no timeouts. The deputy is not allowed.
- All substitutions must be made at the 50-yard line through the substitution area.
- 8 Meters: Can be played out at the end of a half/end of the game.
- Draws will be taken to begin each half and after every goal.
- No handshakes after the game

Pumpkin Division will play 7v7: (6 field players and a goalie)

*All US Lacrosse Rules apply at this event

- No Checking for Pumpkin 7v7 Division
- Teams must be ready to take the field at the conclusion of the previous game. Please be ready to play as you enter the field.
- Time outs: There are no timeouts. The deputy is not allowed.
- All substitutions must be made at the 50-yard line through substitution area.
- 8 Meters: Can be played out at the end of a half/end of the game.
- Draws will be taken to begin each half and after every goal.
- No handshakes after the game

Scoring:

Scores will be kept at the 50-yard line of all fields. Coaches should check scores frequently and will sign off at the end of the game. Scheduled games can end in a tie. If score is tied at the end of the Championship game, there will be one 5 minute sudden death period. If still tied, there will be a full field braveheart.

Teams will receive:

2 points for a win1 point for a tie0 points for a loss

Tie Breakers:

- 1) Head to Head
- 2) Goals Against
- 3) Goals For
- 4) Flip a coin

Checking:

- Full Checking 2026/2027
- Modified Checking 2028/2029
- No Checking Pumpkin Division 2030/31

Goalie Equipment:

- Goalies must wear shin guards, padded pants, chest protector, helmet, mouth and throat guard, and goalie gloves.
- Helmets & chest protectors must be NOCSAE Certified.
- Please make all attempts to have a goalie in the cage. If unable to find a goalie, we will have a shot blocker as a last resort.

Legacy Lacrosse and Laxachusetts follows the US Lacrosse Code of Conduct:
