



2021 Lax Invitational Tournament Rules

- Teams will play current NCAA rules, without shot clocks.
- 2 – 22 minute running time halves will be played.
- Game time will be kept at the scorekeepers table.
- Penalty time will be start/stop and kept at scorekeepers table.
- Teams will be allowed 1 timeout per game.
- 4-minute halftime.
- Teams have 20 seconds to clear the ball over midfield from the defensive half. (Officials will keep the 20 second timer on the field).
- Once the ball has crossed midfield with possession the offensive team may not cross over midfield again (Over & back).
- No diving in the crease.
- Teams will switch sides at the end of the half.
- If officials deem a team to be stalling, a “Timer On” call may be used and the offensive team will have 60 seconds to take a shot.
- If the game is tied at the end of regulation, a 4-minute overtime period will be played and the next goal scored wins.
- There are NO timeouts in overtime.
