

Rules 2022

Showcase Rules

- Home team determined by coin flip at beginning of game.
- All games are 1:20 drop dead finish the batter, no new inning after 1:15.
- All weather and field updates will be through Tourney Machine.
- Be warmed up ready to start games as soon as previous game finishes.
- · Game Balls will be provided by River City.
- Two new balls will be furnished for the first game of the day. After that game, one new ball and one used ball will be provided. Each team needs to be prepared to throw in additional balls thereafter.
- You may bat a minimum of 9 batters and up to 15 batters. Please maintain integrity of the original batting order.
- · Free substitution on defense.
- Three warm up pitches per inning.
- Courtesy runner for pitcher and catcher only. If you have a player with an injury that needs a runner, it is allowed as long as the opposing coach is consulted prior to the move.
- Courtesy runner must be last batted out unless the batter was the current Pitcher or Catcher.
- In the case of a hit batter, batter may choose to stay in batter box or advance. If batter chooses to stay, a runner can be put on base in place of the batter, batter will start a new count.
- Should a College Coach make a request to re-hit a player, re-run a player, or move a player on the field, it is allowed as long as the opposing coach is consulted prior to the move.
- Teams should help retrieve foul balls.
- Parents, fans, players and coaches must return all game balls back promptly to prevent delays.
 All game balls must be returned to the umpires.
- Run rule not in effect for this event.
- Scoring is all runs for every at bat count, but we will not record more than a plus 7 differential. Example 13-0 will be recorded as 7-0.
- No protest allowed. The Showcase provides a UIC at each park. Game and Umpire disputes will be handled by the UIC.
- In the event of inclement weather, there will be an automatic 20-minute rain delay rule in effect. If play cannot resume after 20 minutes, that round of games is CANCELLED. There will be no make-up games.
- No protest allowed. River City provides a UIC at each park. Game and Umpire disputes will be handled by the UIC.
