

Best of the West 2022 COVID Guidelines

- A mask mandate is in effect for all persons as they enter the building(s) and while competing/spectating/working events. Athletes/PIAA officials are able to remove masks when actively participating in their sport. Otherwise, masks for athletes are to remain on while waiting to enter the contest.
- We will not provide masks for those who arrive without a mask at our building and are scheduled to participate as an athlete/coach/official/spectator/worker.
- All arrivals will occur through the gym doors at the high school and proceed through the lobby. Middle school athletics will enter through the middle school main office doors where the canopy is located.
- Any concessions that are offered will be grab 'n go style.
- Please be mindful of the bleacher stickers to sit socially distanced from other visitors.
- Teams and fans must exit the gym immediately following each game unless playing back to back games.
- Groups of players, coaches, and fans are not permitted to congregate in the hallways or lobbies of any West Allegheny School District Building between games.
- Groups identified as not adhering to these guidelines will receive **one** warning, if after receiving the warning the above guidelines continue to not be followed the team(s) in violation will be asked to leave the school campus and forfeit any remaining games without refund.
- If any player or coach begins showing symptoms or tests positive for COVID during the tournament or up to 72 hours following their final tournament game a notification should be sent to info@wagirlsbasketball.com with your team's name, grade, and date/time of symptoms or positive test result. Upon receiving this any teams who competed against the infected person(s) will be notified of the potential contact.
