## SHOW US WHAT YOU GOT TOURNAMENT RULES

In addition to the following rules, MHSAA and NFHS softball rules will be used:

- Teams can start and finish games with 8 uniformed and rostered players. If a team plays with 8 players, the $9^{\text {th }}$ spot in the batting order will be an out. A team with 7 or fewer players will forfeit to the score of 7-0.
- All teams must be ready to play 15 minutes prior to their scheduled game time. Games can begin early.
- Home and away teams will be decided by a coin flip in pool play. In bracket play, the higher seed is the home team.


## Batting order options:

- 9 players in the batting order (DP/Flex or a straight 9 are allowed; all other players are subs).
- 10 players in the batting order (use an EP with or without a DP/Flex; all other players are subs).
- Continuous batting order (all rostered players are in the batting order)

Courtesy runner for pitcher/catcher: Your subs are your courtesy runners if you aren't batting your entire roster. If batting everyone, the last batted out will be the courtesy runner.

Time limit: 70 minutes (finish the inning). Pool games may end in a tie. Only the 12 U and 14 U Championship games will be 90 minutes. International tie-breaker will be used, if necessary, in bracket play.

The tournament director may change game lengths, game times or tournament format due to inclement weather.

Tie Breakers: Head to head; runs allowed; run differential; runs scored; coin toss

Mercy rule: 12 run lead after 3 innings, 10 runs after 4 innings, 8 runs after 5 innings
