March Madness Tournament

- All Games- 15 minute Stop Time halves with 2 minute halftime.
 - Each team will be allowed (3) 30 sec timeouts per game
 - 1 additional timeout for overtime. Timeouts do not carry over.
- Overtime will be 2 minutes long (No ties). 3rd OT is first point wins.
- Players will shoot one-and-one on the 7th foul and two shots on the 10th.
 - Players will foul out of the game on the 6th personal foul.
 - Technical fouls count as personal fouls.
- 4th Grade Girls use 27.5 ball 5th -8th Grade use 28.5 ball.

4th & 5th grade- Only man to man defense will be played.

No zone defense or double teaming.

Full court pressing is only allowed in:

4th Grade - Last 2 minutes of the game and overtime

5th Grade - Last 2 minutes of both halves and overtime

Press must be Man to Man. (No pressing is allowed if leading by 15 points.)

6th -8th Grade Zones and Full Court Pressing is allowed

Teams must play half court defense if leading by 15 points

- 1st team on schedule (on top or left) is Home team.
- Teams should arrive at least 15 minutes prior to their scheduled starting time.

3 Teams Head to Head (must beat both otherwise +/- Points)

Max +/- Points a Game is 20 to avoid running up scores

Coin Flip

Teams with an odd number of teams that play 4 pool games will not have their final pool game count on standings
