

United Lacrosse's 2022 Summer Clash at CBA Tournament Rules

GENERAL:

- o Mouth guards, gloves, arm pads and shoulder pads required
- o Tournament is in "running time" format
- All penalties will be timeserving, 30 seconds or a minute
 - Penalties can be longer than 1 minute and/or "non-releasable" at referee's discretion, just as in standard game play
 - Penalties begin on the official's re-start
- o Any fighting or disrespect towards an official will result in expulsion. The director will determine the length.
- o Man ball is played at all levels
- Long Poles are permitted at all levels (4 poles)
- The ref keeps the official score
- PLAYOFFS: Best Record, Head to Head (If you played each other), goals against, coin flip

GAME PLAY:

- Games consist of TWO 22 minute halves with a 1-minute halftime to switch sides
- 1 time out per team, can not be taken during the last 2 minutes of 2nd half
 - Clock runs during time out
- o Time will be kept at Tournament HQ
- Sub on fly all levels
- o Refs keep the time on penalties and penalties are running time
- One long air horn blast starts the game and one long air horn will end the game
- No mercy rule for all grade levels
- 2 minute long Braveheart will take place in ALL games that end in a tie
 - Each team fields 3 position players and 1 goalie
 - Starts with face-off
 - No offsides and NO SUBS ALLOWED
 - Goalie cannot cross the midfield line
 - First goal wins
 - If no winner then a tie

YOUTH RULES:

- No clearing times will be in effect, though the 4-second crease rule for goalies still applies.
- o Body checking is limited to a "1 step rule"

RULES RELATED TO INCLEMET WEATHER:

- o There are no "rain dates" for the Summer Clash.
- o If inclement weather causes a game stoppage (thunder or lightning) during the event, the following rules apply:
 - Play will stop until Tournament Director decided weather is suitable to resume playing
 - If delay is large, reminder of the game times may be shortened to get tournament back on schedule
