YOUTH VOLLEYBALL RULES

- 1. NET WILL BE ON THE LOWEST SETTING/YOUTH HEIGHT FOR 5/6TH GRADE AND WOMEN'S HEIGHT FOR 7/8TH GRADE.
- 2. OFFICIAL BALL IS A VOLLEY LITE FOR 5/6TH GIRLS AND NORMAL BALL FOR 7/8TH
- 3. UNIFORMS ARE ENCOURAGED WITH NUMBERS
- 4. COACH CALLS TIME OUTS. SUBSTITUTIONS AND DETERMINES STARTING LINE-UP
- 5. WARM UP (OPTIONAL) SERVE OR SIDE DETERMINED BY COIN TOSS OR ROCK, PAPER SCISSORS GAME. 3 MINUTES FOR EACH TEAM
- 6. 3 WAYS TO SCORE: OPPONETS MAKE AN ERROR, OPPONETS GET PENALTY FOR POOR CONDUCT, TEAM PUTS THE BALL DOWN ON OPPONETS COURT. *IF AN ERROR OCCURS SIMULTANEOUSLY A REPLAY IS CALLED, OTHERWISE, THE FIRST FAULT MADE IS THE ONE CALLED AND ERRORS THAT OCCUR AFTERWARDS DO NOT MATTER UNLESS IT IS A CONDUCT VIOLATION.
- 7. SETS ARE AS FOLLOWE (2)25 PT SETS AND (1) 15 PT SET, MUST WIN BY 2 POINTS* THERE WILL BE A 15 MINUTE TIME LIIMIT PER SET; THEREFORE YOU EITHER WIN BY 2 POINTS OR WHOEVER HAS THE MOST POINTS AT THE END OF TIME. IF TIED NEXT PLAY WINS.
- 8. TO WIN THE MATCH YOU MUST WIN 2 SETS, IF A 3RD SET IS NEEDED IT WILL BE PLAYED TO 15 POINTS.
- 9. ROTATIONS FOR SERVERS MOVES ONE IN A CLOCKWISE DIRECTION. AT THE MOMENT OF THE SERVE ALL PLAYERS SHOULD BE ON THE COURT OR COURT LINES.
- 10. BALL IN-THE BALL TOUCHES COMPLETELY OUTSIDE THE PLAYING COURT INCLUDING BOUNDARY LINES.
 - BALL OUT- THE BALL TOUCHES COMPLETELY OUTSIDE THE PLAYING COURT, PASSES UNDER THE NET, OR TOUCHES THE SUPPORT LINES, ANTENNA, POSTS OR THE NET OUTSIDE OF THE ANTENNAS
- 11.
 - THE BALL MAY NOT BE THROWN OR CARRIED. THE BALL CANNOT BE DOUBLE HIT,.
 BALL MUST BE HIT OVER THE NET WITH A MAXIMUM OF 3 CONTACTS. THE BALL CAN
 HIT ANY PART OF A PLAYERS BODY INCLUDING FEET
- 12. BALL HANDLING FAULTS: HITTING THE BALL MORE THAN 4 TIMES AND LIFTING, CARRYING, OR THROWING THE BALL.
- 13. NET PLAY- PLAYERS MAY NOT TOUCH THE NET. THE BALL MAY HIT THE NET AND CONTINUES OVER AT ANY TIME AS LONG AS IT PASSES BETWEEN BOTH ANTENNAS.
- 14. A BALL BLOCKED COUNTS AS A TOUCH, BUT DOES NOT COUNT AS ONE OF THE TEAMS 3 HITS, AND CAN BE PLAYED BY THE BLOCKER, WITHOUT BEING CALLED FOR A DOUBLE HIT. YOU MUST BE ON YOUR SIDE OF THE NET TO BLOCK A BALL. YOU CANNOT BLOCK A SERVE.
- 15. IF AN INJURY OCCURS, STOP THE GAME IMMEDIATELY AND TEND TO THE INJURED PLAYER. A REPLAY IS CALLED. IF A PLAYER HAS A HARD CAST ON, THEY CANNOT PLAY.

EVERYONE SERVES

AFTER 5 POINTS IS SCORED IN A ROW OTHER TEAM SERVES. $5/6^{TH}$ GRADE ONLY $5^{TH}/6^{TH}$ CAN SERVE FROM THE FREE THROW LINE $7^{TH}/8^{TH}$ NORMAL RULES
