On behalf of the Wisconsin Twisters, welcome to the 13th Annual Fall Brawl Tournament. Special thanks to all of the businesses, family members, players, and coaches who work tirelessly to make the tournament a success.

Regulations are subject to change at game time.

- 1. All teams must register with the tournament director **1 hour** prior to playing your first game. (by the concession area) **You will need to turn in a copy of your roster, and insurance.** Please have onsite your birth certificates.
- 2. Continuous batting order is optional (USA rules regarding courtesy runners are to be followed when not using continuous batting order). If utilizing continuous batting order, courtesy runners shall be the last out.
- 3. Game balls will be furnished. Please return all balls to the umpire after each game.
- 3. Game time is forfeit time. **Teams should be ready to play 30 min. prior to game time.** Every effort will be made to keep game ahead of schedule due to limited daylight hours.
- 5. A coin flip will determine the home team for pool play games. The higher seed will be the home team throughout the bracket. The home team will be the official scorekeeper and will be responsible for reporting the scores to the tournament director.
- 6. All games will have a time limit of 75 minutes, except the Championship Game (1st/2nd Place only). Finish the inning. All games must result in a win or lose. International Tie-Breaker will be used throughout the tournament to declare a winner.

 Mercy rule will be in effect in ALL games-15 after 3 innings, 12 after 4 innings and 8 after 5 innings.
 - Seeding will be based off W-L record, head to head, runs allowed, run differential and coin flip.
- 7. No game protest.
- 8. No infield practice between games. Absolutely no activity in the infield area when ground crews are prepping the fields.
- 9. Team Managers will be responsible for all persons including players, coaches and spectators associated with their team.
- 10. Your team is responsible for <u>cleaning up the dugouts</u> after each game. Coaches, please enforce this rule.
