

## **Pride of the North Tournament Rules**

MSHSL rules shall apply with the following modifications:

- 1. Games will be two 18-minute running-time halves for 3rd and 4th grade. Games will be two 20-minute running-time halves for grades 5th through 8th grade. Stop time during the last 2 minutes at the end of the game unless a team is ahead by 15 points.
- Overtime periods If needed the first overtime period will be two-minutes stop-time. The second will be sudden victory (first team to score), with the following exception: Championship games will be two-minute stop-time periods until a winner has been determined.
- 3. One and one will be shot on the seventh team foul in each half of the game double bonus on the tenth team foul.
- 4. Each team is allowed 3 one-minute timeouts for the game and 1 one-minute timeout per overtime. Note: Timeouts from regulation will not be carried over into the overtime session.
- 5. There will be a 5-minute warm-up before each game and a 3-minute half time. Note: If the games are falling behind schedule, it will be up to the official's discretion to decrease warm-up time.
- 6. A 10-minute grace period from the scheduled start time shall be allowed before a forfeit is declared for the **first game only.**
- 7. **Technical Fouls:** Automatic two points and the ball will be given to the opposing team. Two technical fouls on any player or coach will result in ejection from the game and will need to leave the site.
- 8. All protests will be settled by the officials on the court.
- 9. If a team has only five players and a player fouls out, that player may remain in the game. But that player's team will be assessed a technical foul on each subsequent foul by the player who has 5 or more fouls, with the opposing team being awarded the two points and possession of the ball.
- 10. Basket height for ALL GRADES is 10 ft.
- 11. No press at the 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4th and 5th grade levels, except for the last 2 minutes of the game. No press allowed by 3rd, 4th and 5th grade teams that are ahead by 20 points or more in the last 2 minutes of the game.
- 12. Grades 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> may press at any time unless the difference in the score is greater than 20.
- 13. DEFENSE: Grades 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> may play any defense. Grades 3rd-5th only man-to-man defense is allowed.
- 14. Running time will be used if more than a 15 point lead is held by either team in the last 2 minutes of the second half.
- 15. The three-point rule will be in effect wherever there are three point lines designated.
- 16. Girls 3<sup>rd</sup> 8<sup>th</sup> grade and Boys 3<sup>rd</sup> 6<sup>th</sup> grade will use a women's basketball (28.5"), while the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade boys will use a men's basketball (29.5").
- 17. The Free Throw line for 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade will be 12'. Jumping over the free throw line will be allowed.
- 18. A player may not play on more than one team per grade or school.
- 19. Repeated unsportsmanlike conduct by players, coaches, parents, or fans shall not be tolerated and the individual will be asked to leave the site. Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their fans. If a spectator refuses to leave, the game will be forfeited by the offending team.
- 20. **NO SHOOTING** is allowed at halftime or timeouts except by the teams participating in the game.
