

2023 Aurora Baseball Tournament

Base Running Relay Rules

- \$5.00 per participant (\$10.00 per group). Cash payment only. Must have an adult present to register.
- 2 participants per group. Both participants must be on the same roster of a team participating in the tournament.
- Each participant may only compete in one group.
- There is a maximum of 3 groups (6 participants) per team. Relay Official may issue exceptions.
- All age groups will compete on 60ft bases.
- Each group must supply their own baseball to use as a relay baton.
- Medals awarded to the Champions in each division (8U/9U/10U/11U/12U/13U/14U)
- All decisions by the Relay Official are FINAL.

Scoring

- Both participants will start and finish their turn at home plate and make one complete lap around the bases.
- Each participant must start with one foot touching home plate the second runner can not leave home plate until the ball is in their possession.
- Each participant must touch every base on their turn. Every missed base will add a 15 second penalty to the total time.
- The transfer of the baseball from one runner to the next must be a handoff (both runners must be touching the ball at the same time).
- When the first runner returns to home plate they are not required to touch home plate. The second runner is required to touch home plate.
- Time will begin at the first motion of the first runner and end when the second runner touches home plate.
- Each group will get two attempts. The faster of the two times will be the official time for the group.
- The group with the fastest time will be the Champions.
- In the event of a tie, the two times for the group will be added. The group with the fastest total time will be the Champions.
