

What to expect for the Nov 18-20 Wildcat Shootout

In co-hosting this event with the Mt. Si HS boys' basketball booster club, please see how this is specific to the games that will be played Nov 18-20, 2022. Please see how this general info has been updated so that coaches, players and fans can know how things will be set up and the protocols that will need to be followed at the gym where they play their games.

*****Updated as of November 16, 2022*****

Entrance and exit –

Games will begin every 65 minutes.

Each team will be allowed **one head coach and two assistant coaches, and we will need those coaches to sign in at the admission table when they check in for their first game each day** so that our staff can account for them and get each coach a wristband. All coaches should expect to sit on the team bench in a support role, not as a fan or team videographer, etc.

Once each game is over, we ask all fans, coaches and players to exit the building immediately. Please plan to do any post game team meetings or social interactions outside so that we don't have anyone lingering in the building and potentially compromising our staff's ability to stay on schedule.

Admissions and seating –

Admissions will be charged differently for this particular event, prior to spectators entering the court area. This admission fee, and then by showing the wristband that you receive, will get you into your team's game(s) on that day, if you purchase just the daily admission, or for the balance of the weekend if you purchase the tournament pass.

Daily - \$10 daily for adults.

Daily - \$8 daily for senior citizens and students aged 7-18.

Children aged 6 and under are free.

SPECTATORS MAY PURCHASE A TOURNAMENT PASS PRIOR TO THEIR TEAM'S FIRST GAME OF THE WEEKEND, SOME TEAMS WITH A FRIDAY EVENING FIRST GAME, OTHER TEAMS WITH A FIRST GAME OF THE EVENT ON SATURDAY. THIS PRICE WILL GET YOU A RED WRISTBAND THAT WE ASK THAT YOU WEAR FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE WEEKEND SO THAT OUR EVENT STAFF CAN IDENTIFY YOU AS HAVING ALREADY PAID TO GET IN FOR THE REST OF THE WEEKEND. IF YOU REFUSE TO PUT THE WRISTBAND ON, LOSE THE WRISTBAND DURING THE WEEKEND, ETC., OUR EVENT STAFF WILL HAVE TO CHARGE YOU ANOTHER ADMISSION FEE TO GET BACK INTO THE GYMS.

Adults can pay \$25 on Friday for the pass that will get them in Fri-Sat-Sun.

Adults can pay \$15 on Saturday for the pass that will get them in Sat-Sun.

Seniors and students can pay \$20 on Friday, and that will get them in Fri-Sat-Sun.

Seniors and students can pay \$12 on Saturday, and that will get them in Sat-Sun.

Cash payment of admissions fees is preferred, but we do now have options to Venmo, Cashapp, or PayPal your admission fee if any fans happen to arrive at the gym with no cash. Please expect to show your proof of payment to our event staff to receive your hand stamp and enter the building.

No players from other teams, nor siblings of players, nor any other parent or spectator should be attempting to sit in the area designated as the team bench.

Parents need to keep younger siblings seated with their group so that we do not have young children drifting around the facility unsupervised during the game.

These are rules that the event staff is expected to enforce, so we hope that this is not seen as an opportunity to debate or argue from a philosophical perspective. We understand that many people have varying beliefs, feelings and concerns about how things have been managed, so we are not passing judgment or attempting to sway anyone from their perspective with the way that we operate, but are merely maintaining the established rules so that we can remain a business in good standing and be allowed to continue to host these games for the teams in our state.
