

- Six pool games seeded into a Best 4 team single-elimination bracket
- Tournament Director reserves the right to change the format if necessary
- USA Softball Rules govern all games.
- Teams will be awarded double points based upon the final order of finish
- Pay the umpire at the plate all games are \$50.00 per team

Pool Games

• Games will be seven innings or a time limit 75 minutes; finish the inning, whichever occurs first. Pool games can end in a tie..

- A coin flip will determine the home team.
- · Maximum of five runs per half inning
- Run rules 10 after 3, 8 after 4, 6 after 5

Bracket Games

- 4 Teams will be seeded into a single elimination bracket based on pool play win/loss record.
- If two or more teams have the same win/loss record, seeds will be determined by:
- 1. Head-to-head results in pool play
- 2. Fewest runs allowed in pool play
- 3. Most runs scored in pool play
- 4. Highest seeded team has the option of being home/visitors
- Games will be seven innings in length or a time limit of 75 minutes; finish the inning, whichever occurs first.
- Bracket games cannot end in a tie.
- If the game is tied upon completion of 7 innings or after time has expired, teams will
 continue to play using the USA Softball Tie-Breaker Rule until a winner has been
 determined.
- In addition to normal options of batting 9 players with or without a DP/Flex, teams have the option of batting as many players as they wish and including their entire roster.
- Teams must have an eligible substitute to take advantage of the courtesy runner rule.
- If a player has to leave the game for any reason, including injury, and an eligible substitute is not available:
- 1. An out will be charged for each turn at bat
- 2. If the player who has to leave the game is a batter or runner, the batter or runner will be declared out.
- 3. An inning or game can end with an automatic out.
- 4. The player who has left the game may not return to the line-up.
- The highest seeded team will have the option of being the home team.
- Maximum of 5 runs per half inning
- Run rules 10 after 3, 8 after 4, 6 after 5

ADDITIONS/EXCEPTIONS TO USA SOFTBALL RULEBOOK

- In addition to normal options of batting 9 players with or without a DP/Flex, teams have the option of batting as many players as they wish up to and including their entire roster.
- Teams must have an eligible substitute in order to take advantage of the courtesy runner rule.
