

## Pete Doumit Memorial Rules

## RULES \& GAME LENGTH:

Cal Ripken and Babe Ruth rules with pitching rule modifications for the tournament.

- 8u-12u GAME TIMES: 6 Innings or 1 hour and 40 minutes. No new inning may be started after time has expired. A new inning starts when the previous inning ends. 3rd/4th place game will have a time limit. *No time limit on the Championship game ONLY, yet Mercy Rules still apply.
- 13u-14u GAME TIMES: 7 Innings or 1 hour and 50 minutes. No new inning may be started after time has expired. A new inning starts when the previous inning ends. 3rd/4th place game will have a time limit. *No time limit on the Championship game ONLY, yet Mercy Rules still apply.
- MERCY RULES 12 runs after $21 / 2$ or 3 innings 10 runs after $31 / 2$ or 4 innings or any time after.


## Ties 9-14U Rules

- TIES: If there is a tie at the end of the game, the Tie Breaker will apply. Each team will start the inning with the player who was last recorded OUT, as a Base Runner on 2nd base with one (1) out already on the books.
- *Pool-play: There must be time left on the clock to incorporate the Tie Breaker. If time has expired the game will end in a tie! (no new inning may be started after time has expired in any Pool-play game).
- *Seeding/Play-off: Games will always incorporate the Tie Breaker in Play-off games, at end of time limit.


## $\underline{9 U / 10 U \& 11 / 12 U ~ R u l e s}$

## PITCHING RULES

- 9U/10U- No Balks will be called, just warnings.
- $11 \mathrm{U} / 12 \mathrm{U}$ - Balks will be called after one warning.
- 9U/10U-Pitchers are allowed 3 innings per game with a maximum of 7 innings per Tournament. Pitchers will receive (1) EXTRA Inning for the Championship Game ( 7 innings $+1=8$ TOTAL.)
- $11 \mathrm{U} / 12 \mathrm{U}$-Pitchers are allowed 3 innings per game with a maximum of 8 innings per Tournament. Pitchers will receive (1) EXTRA Inning for the Championship Game ( 8 innings $+1=9$ TOTAL.)
- Once the pitcher is removed from the mound he may not re-enter as a pitcher.
- A pitcher must be removed from the mound upon the 2nd visit by the coach/manager in that same inning. Each pitcher is allowed 2 visits by the coach.
Violation of Pitching Rules = Ejection of the head coach "and" the pitcher in question.


## STARTING/ENDING THE GAME

- Teams may warm-up in the outfield grass before their game if time permits. Game time is "Forfeit Time". Be ready to play. No formal infield/outfield is allowed prior to the game. No soft-toss into the chain link fence is allowed.
- A coin flip will determine the Home Team before the game for pool play. The higher seeded team will be designated Home Team for playoffs.


## A few reminders:

- All bats must be stamped USAbats!
- No pitcher to catcher rule restrictions.
- No Slug Bunts allowed. The batter will be called out if he turns to bunt and swings away.
- No Head-First slides allowed. Runners may dive head-first only when returning to a base.
- If a runner attempting to reach home plate intentionally/maliciously runs into a defensive player in the area of home plate, he will be called out and ejected from the game. This is a judgment call by the umpire. Players return to the bases last touched at the collision.
- Courtesy runners are allowed for current pitcher and catcher only, must be a player not in the lineup, if roster batting then the furthest batter away.
- A player judged by the umpire as throwing the bat after successfully hitting the ball will be warned once. 2 nd offense by the same player will result in an out. 3rd offense by any player on the team will result in an ejection.
- No lead-off: $9 \mathrm{u}-10 \mathrm{u}=$ No drop ball strike three. $11 \mathrm{u}-12 \mathrm{u}=$ Drop ball strike three
- 9U ONLY!!! Max allowed runs of 5 per inning.


## SEEDING:

1.Record,
2.Head to Head,
3.Runs Allowed/max runs allowed-10 per game,
4.Runs Scored/max runs scored-10 per game,
5.Coin Toss *Runs Allowed examples: you win (13 to $12=$ Runs allowed are 10$) \&(7$ to $5=$ Runs allowed are 5$)$
*Runs Scored example: you win (13 to $12=$ Runs scored are 10$) \&(7$ to $5=$ Runs scored are 7 )

## SPORTSMANSHIP

All players, coaches and fans will be expected to conduct themselves in a sportsmanship manner at all times. Heckling, taunting, rude gestures and disparaging remarks will not be tolerated. That person or persons will be removed from the ballpark.

## 13U/14U Rules

13u-14u: pitchers are allowed 10 innings per tournament. However we ask that coaches use discretion to guarantee the safety of their athletes.

Headfirst slide allowed into all bases.
All bats must be stamped BBCOR OR USAbats!
Courtesy runners are allowed for current pitcher and catcher only, must be a player not in the lineup, if roster batting then the furthest batter away.
