

# **Fundamental Hoops**

## **Ken Waldie/Bruce Blood Memorial Tournament Rules**

- All Games- 15 minute Stop Time halves with 2 minute halftime.
  - Each team will be allowed (3) 30 sec timeouts per game
  - 1 additional timeout for overtime. Timeouts do not carry over.
- Overtime will be 2 minutes long (No ties). 3<sup>rd</sup> OT is first point wins.
- Players will shoot one-and-one on the 7<sup>th</sup> foul and two shots on the 10<sup>th</sup>.
  - Players will foul out of the game on the 6<sup>th</sup> personal foul.
    - Technical fouls count as personal fouls.
      - Boys 4<sup>th</sup> 28.5 ball. 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> 29.5 ball.
      - 4<sup>th</sup> girls 27.5, 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> Girls Games 28.5 ball
      - Any defense allowed in grades 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>.
    - No full court press allowed if up by 15 points.
- 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Grade: Man to man half-court defense only. Help and recover defense allowed. Man-to-man full court pressing is allowed in the last 2 minutes of each half. No zones allowed at any time, including during press. 1st offense will be a warning and 2nd offense will be a technical foul (Referee's discretion).
  - No full court press allowed if up by 15 points.
- If game is more than 20 points with 5 minutes to go, game is running time until under.
  - 1<sup>st</sup> team on schedule (on top or left ) is Home team.
- Teams should arrive 15 minutes prior to their scheduled starting time.

Tie Breakers are as followed:

Pool Record

Head to Head with Teams Tied (must defeat both teams in a 3 way tie)

+/- Points (a max of 20 points per game)

Head to Head (if eliminates 1 team from +/-)

Lowest Pts Against

Coin Toss
