Tournament Rules

- 1. Tournament Director: Steve Staszak (330)573-6302; stevenjstazak@gmail.com
- 2. This Tournament is open to all Community Teams and Teams with a roster of at least 60% players from the same community/school district. This is NOT a Nation's qualifying tournament.
- 3. Teams must provide their own insurance.
- 4. The Birth Date cut off is the player's age on April 30th.
- 5. Birth Certificates must be available in the event of a protest. If a manager cannot produce a player's BC upon request, his team will forfeit that game and the player will remain ineligible until a BC is produced. Copies are acceptable if they are legible. Any illegible copies will be considered unacceptable.
- 6. Little League Rules will apply, except where noted differently below.
- 7. Players' jerseys do not have to be identical but must have a different number.
- 8. Weather Cancellation Policy:
 - a. 0 games played = \$300 refund (8U \$200)
 - b. 1 game played = \$200 refund (8U \$150)
 - c. 2 games played = Tournament considered complete.
- 9. Players may only be active on one roster per weekend.
- 10. Refund Policy if the team backs out before the tournament:
 - a. 100% refund if before March 1st.
 - b. 50% refund if the team resigns after March 1st.
 - c. \$0 if after April 1st.
- 11. All teams must be ready to begin play within 15 min after the end of the previous game.
- 12. Teams may play with a minimum of 9 players and a maximum of 14. If a player shows up after the first pitch, he may enter the game but must be added to the bottom of the batting order.
- 13. Home/Visitor by coin flip in pool play. In bracket play, the higher seed is the home team.
- 14. The home team is the official scorer. Scorekeepers need to confirm the score every inning.
- 15. The winning team must report the final score to the Concession stand/Field Director.
- 16. Warms-ups are permitted in the outfield and foul territory of the infield only.
- 17. No hit sticks outside of the fences. All kids with a bat must have a helmet on.
- 18. Pool games 1 hr. 45 min time limit. No inning shall start after 1 hr. 45 min. Once started, the inning must finish. New innings start when the last out is made of the previous inning.
- 19. *Shootout if the regulation game ends in a tie or the time limit is reached. No time limit on the Championship game.
- 20. Pool play consists of 2 games. Pool records will determine seeding.
- 21. Bracket seeding will be determined in this order:
 - a. W-L record
 - b. Head-to-Head

- c. Highest run differential (Max of 10 per game)
- d. Lowest runs against score (Max of 10 per game)
- e. and if still needed, a Coin Flip
- 22. Any player, Coach, or Fan ejected from the game will NOT be permitted to be present at the team's next game. This is non-negotiable. If a player, Coach, or Fan is found on the premises after being ejected, then that team will be forced to forfeit that game.

Game Play Rules

- 1. Little League Rules will apply, except where noted differently.
- 2. Maximum of 14 on roster, (you can have more, but I can only guarantee 14 Trophies).
- 3. Continuous batting order.
- 4. Minimum Playing Time: 2 defensive innings/game unless the game is ended due to mercy rule.
- 5. Pitchers: 3 innings/game, 6/day, 9/tournament.
- 6. Pool/Bracket games = 6 innings. 2hr time limit. No new inning after 1hr. 45 min. If tied at the time limit or end of 6 innings, then *Shootout.
- 7. No time limit in the Championship game. *Shootout if tied after 8 innings. (Start the 9th inning with the shootout).
- 8. The courtesy runner for Catcher is allowed with 2 outs. Runner must be the player who made the last out.
- 9. Dropped 3rd strike will be in effect for 11U 14U. No dropped 3rd strike for 9U & 10U.
- 10. Leadoffs and stealing are permitted for 11U 14U.
 - a. Runners do not have to wait for the ball to cross the plate.
- 11. No leadoff/stealing until the ball reaches the plate for 9U & 10U.
 - a. If a player leaves early: 1st offense = Team warning. 2nd = runner is out.
- 12. Base runners can score on passed ball/Wild pitch.
- 13. Bat Restrictions: USA or USSSA-approved bats will be in effect this year.
- 14. No run limit per inning in 9U, 10U, 11U, 12U or 14U.
- 15. Mercy Rule: 15 runs after 3 innings; 12 after 4 innings. 10 after 5.
- 16. Player Injury: If a player is injured and unable to bat for the remainder of the game, then he will be skipped in the batting order without being considered an out.
- 17. Protest Fee: \$100 cash, paid at time of protest. Protest must be filed before the next pitch. The Tournament Director will be the judge of the final decision. If the Tournament Director is unavailable, then succession will be as follows: TLL President, VP, or Field Manager.
- 18. *Shootout Rules: If the last inning ends in a tie, or if the time limit is up and you finish the inning, the following innings will be Shootouts. The visiting team starts an extra inning with the player who was their last out (previous inning) on 2nd base. Each Batter steps to the

- plate with a 2-1 count. The play continues until 3 outs. The home team then bats with the same rules. The game continues until the inning ends with a winner.
- 19. In case of rain-shortened game: Games are deemed official after 2 ½ innings of play, if the home team is winning, and 3 innings if the home team is losing. Tie is an option in pool play in this scenario.
- 20. Bracket play is single elimination.

Pitching Restrictions

- 1. 9U-14U: 3 innings per game. 6 innings per day. 9 per tournament.
- 2. The pitcher may return to the mound during a game if he has not pitched his 3 innings.
- 3. Balks
 - a. 11U-14U
 - b. No Bulks for 9U-10U.
- 4. One pitch in an inning = 1 inning pitched. (no 1/3 innings). This applies in a *Shootout too.
- 5. Manager/Coach must initial the opposing team's Pitcher's log which must indicate who pitched and the number of innings pitched. Shootout does count as innings pitched.
- 6. Pitching distance:
 - a. 8U = 42/60
 - b. 9U/10U = 46/60
 - c. 11U/12U = 50/70
 - d. 14U = 60/90
- 7. The pitcher must be removed if he hits 3 batters.
- 8. Manager/Coach mound visits allowed. 1 per inning, if 2, then the pitcher must be removed.

8U CP Rules

- 1. Little League Rules apply except where noted differently below.
- 2. Infield Dead Ball Rule in effect. The infielder must raise the ball overhead, in fair territory, for play to be considered dead. Runners at that point past the Hash mark will advance to the next base. Runners behind the hash mark will return to the previous base. Play is not dead until an infielder raises the ball over his head in the field of play. Play may be made on runners at any time unless the ball is raised overhead by an infielder in fair territory.
- 3. Runners may advance on overthrows.
- 4. Field set up: 10ft circle centered 42 feet from home plate. Hash marks halfway between bases. Coach Pitcher must have one foot inside of the circle at the time of the Pitch.

- 5. The ball is dead if Coach Pitcher is unintentionally hit by the ball. The batter must hit again. If the Coach intentionally comes into contact with the ball (other than to protect the player pitcher), then the batter is out, and all base runners return to the previous base.
- 6. Continuous Batting Order is Mandatory with free player substitution, but the batting order must remain the same.
- 7. All players must play at least 2 defensive innings unless the game ends in a Mercy Rule or time expires.
- 8. 6 inning game. 80 Minute time limits. *8U Shootout Rules if the regulation game ends in a tie.
- 9. Bat Restrictions: USA or USSA-approved bats.
- 10. Mercy Rule: 15 runs after 3 innings. 12 after 4 innings. 10 after five.
- 11. Run limit per inning = 7, except the last inning is unlimited.
- 12. The batter may receive up to 6 pitches to get the ball into play or get out. No Walks. No strikeouts. The batter is out if the batter does not swing or swings and misses on the 6th pitch. If the batter fouls off the 6th pitch, the at-bat will remain alive until the batter, does not swing, swings and misses, or puts the ball into play.
- 13. The Defensive Player designated as Pitcher is not permitted to leave the Pitcher's Circle until the ball is hit. First offense = warning. 2nd offense = player is to be removed from the pitcher for the remainder of that game. One foot inside the circle is considered inside the circle for both the player pitcher and Coach Pitcher.
- 14. No stealing, no leadoffs, no bunts. The umpire will call the batter out if bunted ball.
- 15. Runners may not leave the base until the ball is hit. 1st offense = team warning. 2nd offense = the runner is out.
- 16. Courtesy Runner for Catcher with 2 outs. A courtesy runner must be the player who made the last out.
- 17. The defensive team is allowed one Coach in the Outfield only.
- 18. Defense will consist of 10 players, 4 of which must be in the outfield if playing with 10 players.
- 19. Pool play consists of 2 games. Pool records will determine seeding.
- 20. Bracket seeding will be determined in this order:
 - a. W-L record
 - b. Head-to-Head
 - c. Highest run differential (Max of 10 per game)
 - d. Lowest runs against (Max of 10 per team)
 - e. Coin Flip
- 21. Single elimination in bracket play.

- 22. Any player, Coach, or Fan ejected from the game will NOT be permitted to be present at the team's next game. This is non-negotiable. If a player, Coach, or Fan is found on the premise after being ejected, then that team will be forced to forfeit that game.
- 23. Have fun!

*8U Shootout Rules: The hitting team starts the inning with the player who was their last out (previous inning) on 2nd base. Each Batter gets one pitch (such as the 6th pitch in regulation innings) until 3 outs. The home team then bats with the same rules. The game continues until the inning ends with a winner. This does NOT apply to the Championship game. No time limit for the Championship game.
