# Storm Summer Classic College Showcase Rules

#### TOURNAMENT INFO:

- All coaches must email proof of insurance to michiganstormsoftball@gmail.com
- All teams must have birth certificates available on hand
  - o Failure to produce proof of age for any questioned player will result in forfeiture of all games in which player participate
  - Women's Division No proof of age is needed
- There will be no onsite registration since proof of insurance is required prior to starting
- All College coaches will have rosters sent to them one week prior to tournament
  - Complete rosters through TourneyMachine
- Limited t-shirt sales will be available
  - Pre-Ordered t-shirts: available at the field of your first scheduled game from Site Supervisor
  - o On-site t-shirt sales: \$20/shirt cash or check made payable to Take PRIDE Training, LLC or VENMO @MIStorm\_Softball.
  - Bomb Squad Shirts If a player hits an over the fence homerun, they are to report to the Site Supervisor to receive a bomb squad t-shirt (one per athlete)

## TOURNAMENT RULES:

- This is a non-sanctioned tournament
- Reporting to Fields:
  - o Coach/Manager check in with Site Supervisor 1 hour prior to start time
  - o If the game scheduled before ends early, next game will start up to 10 minutes ahead of the schedule
- Dugouts are on a first come basis.
- All warm-ups should take place off the dirt infield
- Home Team: determined by a coin flip prior to all games and conducted by the umpires
- Warm up pitches:
  - 3 for the first inning, 1 pitch every other inning. New pitchers, 3 warm up pitches.
- Unlimited defensive substitutions
- Teams must bat a minimum of 9 batters
- PGF Rules Applied:
  - With the exception of unlimited # of batters may bat since this is an open/showcase tournament
  - o If a team chooses to bat their entire line-up, the last batted out will be used as the courtesy runner for the pitcher and the catcher only. If there are subs on the bench, the substitutes would be the courtesy runners.
- Pitching Rule (NOT PGF rule):
  - The pitcher can step back with the non-pivot foot prior to or simultaneous with the hands coming together then take a forward step with that foot and deliver the ball. Once the hands are together no further backward step is allowed.
- Run Ahead Rule: 12 runs after 3 innings, 10 runs after 4 innings and 8 runs after 5 innings
- Injury: if an injury occurs and the team is batting their entire line-up or have used up their substitutes, and the player cannot continue, an out will be recorded upon their at bat
- Teams may start and end with 8 players but no less at any point in the game
- Helmet straps are NOT required

# **POOL PLAY:**

- 3 game pool play format then single elimination championship bracket play
- 9u/10u/11u/12u/14u/Women's Division:
  - Teams will be seeded in a single elimination bracket based on pool play
  - Higher seed will be home team
- 16u/18u Divisions:
  - Blind draw for the 1<sup>st</sup> round of single elimination bracket play
  - o Coin flip at the pre-game meeting to determine home team

# BRACKET SEEDING (9u/10u/11/12u/14u/Women's only):

- Best Record
- Head to Head
- Runs allowed
- Run differential (maximum of 8 runs per game)

#### TIME:

- In the spirit of fair play, the coaches are asked to not intentionally stall or delay a game
- The umpires will keep the official time and the home team will keep the official book
- Game time starts as soon as the pre-game meeting concludes
- Pool Play 16u/18u:
  - 80-min, drop dead, finish the batter! Games DO NOT revert to the previous inning
  - Pool games are exposure games therefore wins and losses do not affect your bracket seeding
- Pool Play 9u/10u/11u/12u/14u/women's:
  - o 80-min, drop dead, finish the batter
  - Games can end in a tie
  - o If the visiting team takes the lead and time expires, game will revert to the last completed inning
  - If the home team takes the lead or ties the game, and time expires, that is the final score
- Bracket Play:
  - o 75-minutes, finish the inning
  - Championship game: 90-minute, finish the inning
  - o If a game is tied after 7 innings or time has been reached, international tiebreaker rule will go into effect
  - No game can end in a tie during bracket play

#### **REFUNDS:**

- Refunds given to teams that withdraw less than 120 days prior to the tournament's start date, less a \$150 admin fee if a replacement team is found
- If no replacement team is found, no refund will be issued
- If the tournament must be canceled prior to the start due to an act of God, teams will be refunded 80% of their entry fee
- Day of Tournament Inclement Weather
  - If NO games are played a refund of 60% of team's tournament registration fee will be returned
  - If 1 game is played, the registration fee is fully earned, and no refunds will be given.
  - o Tournament committee reserves the right to change the format of the tournament at any time in an attempt to get all games played
    - All updates will be sent out through tourney machine

## **UMPIRES:**

- We have hard working, experienced, and certified umpires with USA, PGF, NCAA and MHSAA experience
- Because of the strict time limit, the umpire's decisions and judgments will be final There will be no protests
- Final decisions on the operation of the tournament itself will be made by the tournament director, Deb Sleeman

## AWARDS:

- All Divisions Sponsor trophies for 1st and 2nd place teams
- 16u/18u/Women's Division Championship t-shirts for 1st place
- 10u/12u/14u Divisions Medals for 1st place teams

## SPORTSMANSHIP:

- We have a responsibility as coaches to set the example of proper game conduct
- No inappropriate behavior will be tolerated
- All games are to be played in a respectful manner towards players, coaches, umpires, and fans
- No profanity will be accepted
- For any player/coach ejection, that individual will sit out their next game
